

Gmail ends support of Outlook Versions

To be honest, Google and Microsoft never really got along. Making Gmail work inside Outlook porperly has always been somewhat of a challenge. Initially, we simply added it to Outlook and people were able to use Outlook to look at their Google accounts in a more familiar application. Then, Google began forcing users to allow access for "less secure Apps" by changing some Gmail security settings. And it only go harder from there...

Now it's official. As of May 30, Google is eliminating access to Gmail by 3rd party apps that are "less secure." Specifically, Outlook 2016 and earlier, or any app which asks you to sign into your Google account using only your username and password. However, we are still seeing manny issues with Outlook misbehaving when used as a Gmail interface.

Considering this, if you have these versions of Outlook and you have a Gmail account integrated with it, you may wish to either upgrade your Office version (no guarantee this will fix any issues you are having with Google), rely solely on Gmail's web version, or switch over to Office 365.
