 - Sender: Verify the email address or phone number.
 - Links: Hover over links to check their legitimacy.
 - Attachments: Don't open unexpected attachments.
 - Message: Watch out for messages that create urgency or seem off.
- 4. Don't click on unexpected links or attachments.
- 5. Always verify communication directly with Aeros before taking action.
- 6. Be wary of pop-up ads.
- 7. Pop-ups that warn of viruses or ask for personal info are likely scams.




